Present Weather: Cloudy skies with showers

Winds: Moderate breeze at 16mph from the NE

Temperature: 24°C / 75°F

Humidity: 91%

Sea Level Pressure: 1017.2mbs or 30.04"

Sunset: Today 5:35 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: Easterly ranging between 9 to 14mph today, gradually increasing to 18mph by early tomorrow.

Seas: 1.5 to 2.1 metres or 5 to 7 feet consisting of northerly swells with surfs breaking as high as 1.5 metres or 5 feet. Sea bathers should exercise caution.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:

Weather today: The Atlantic high pressure system is the dominant weather feature. This will result in a relatively stable air mass over the area thereby inhibiting any significant shower activity.

Weather today: Partly sunny skies with a 20 percent or a slight chance of showers.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 30 percent or a low chance of showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: A weak trough in the vicinity of the Virgin Islands will result in at most a moderate chance of showers across these islands as well as Anguilla and St. Maarten today. Similar conditions are expected across Trinidad, mainly on the eastern side resulting from surface convergence. Dry air over the area however, will contribute to keeping significant cloud development to bare minimum. Elsewhere, a high pressure system will dominate, keeping the atmosphere relatively stable and will therefore restrict any significant shower activity.
