**Present Weather:** Partly Cloudy

**Winds:** Moderate Breeze of 13 mph from the ENE

**Temperature:** 24°C/75°F      **Humidity:** 74%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1018.7mb or 30.08"

**Sunrise:** Tom 6:44 am

**Sunset:** Today 6:02 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** East at average speeds between 14 to 21 mph with occasional higher gust over coastal waters and elevated terrain.

**Seas:** 1.8 to 2.8 meters or 6 to 9 feet with northerly swells between 1.5 to 1.8 meters or 5 to 6 feet; **A small craft warning and a high surf advisory remains in effect mainly for the north facing coastal waters.** Seas are safer for marine activity along the south and southwestern side of the islands.

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:**

Weather today: Partly cloudy with a 20 percent or slight chance of a brief passing shower.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 20 percent or slight chance of a brief passing shower.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** Shallow pockets of moisture embedded within a moderate to fresh breeze will move across the islands during the next 24 hours and cause skies across the islands from the Windwards southwards to Trinidad and Tobago to be generally partly cloudy with a slight shower. Similar weather is expected over the Leewards. Meanwhile, a diffused moisture boundary will generate variably cloudy skies with passing showers over the BVI's and Puerto Rico.
