**Weather Bulletin**

**Issued at:** 7am

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2019

**Present Weather:** Partly to Cloudy skies with slight haze

**Winds:** A Gentle breeze of 9mph from the East northeast.

**Temperature:** 29°C/83°F      **Humidity:** 76%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1012.4mbs or 29.89"

**Sunrise:** Tom 5:59 am

**Sunset:** Today 6:12 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** East with speeds ranging between 8 – 17mph.

**Seas:** 1.5 - 2.5m or 5 - 8ft consisting of northeasterly swells of 1.5m or 5ft with surfs breaking at greater than 7ft. **A high surf advisory for beachgoers remains in effect until this afternoon mainly for the Atlantic coastal waters.**

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:** Partly sunny and slightly hazy with a 20 percent or a slight chance of showers.

**Weather tonight:** Partly cloudy with a 30 percent or a low chance of early morning showers.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** A Relatively dry and stable atmosphere will persist across most of the Eastern Caribbean ahead of Tropical Storm Jerry as a high pressure system dominates; except for Trinidad and Tobago who will see unsettled weather associated with the Inter Tropical Convergence Zone. Meanwhile, a north Atlantic cyclone is generating marginally unsafe seas across the island chain.
