Weather Bulletin

Sunday 22nd September, 2019

Present Weather: Cloudy skies with haze

Winds: Moderate breeze of 13mph from the Northeast.

Temperature: 29°C/83°F **Humidity:** 82%

Sea Level Pressure: 1014.1mbs or 29.94"

Sunrise: Tom 5:59 am

Sunset: Today 6:07 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: East-southeast at 14 – 21mph and gusting higher in showers.

Seas: 1.2 - 2.4m or 4 - 8ft with swells peaking to near 1.5m or 5ft; **therefore, high surf advisory remains in effect for beachgoers. Small craft operators exercise should caution.**

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 70 percent or high chance of showers.

Weather tonight: Cloudy with a 70 percent or high chance of showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Newly formed tropical Storm Karen will bring heavy rainfall, thunderstorms and winds sometimes reaching tropical storm force strength to the Windward Islands, Barbados and Trinidad and Tobago. Tropical storm warnings are in effect for Trinidad and Tobago and; Grenada and the Grenadines. Some moisture and instability will remain in the atmosphere over the Leeward Islands and hence, the chances of showers will remain high across the islands today and tonight. Meanwhile, a drier and more stable environment across the Virgin Islands west to Puerto Rico will yield very little showers under generally partly cloudy skies.
