Present Weather: Cloudy skies

Winds: Gentle breeze of 9mph from the East-southeast.

Temperature: 28°C/82°F **Humidity:** 79%

Sea Level Pressure: 1013.1mbs or 29.91"

Sunrise: Tom 6:01 am **Sunset:** Today 6:06 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: Southeast at 12 to 23mph occasionally gusting higher and becoming more southerly by tonight.

Seas: 1.8 to 2.1 meters or 6 to 7 feet. Small craft operators should exercise caution against choppy seas mainly in the coastal waters west of the islands.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: The broad circulation of Tropical Storm Karen will push deep-layered moisture over the Leewards and this will contribute to a heighten chance of showers over the Leewards today and tonight.

Rainfall accumulations could total between 6 to 25.4mm or 0.25 to 1.00 inch

Weather today: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 60 percent or moderate chance of morning showers with the chance of showers increasing this afternoon with a slight chance of thunderstorms.

Weather tonight: Mostly cloudy with occasional showers mixed with lighter rain.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Deep layered moisture in association with Tropical Storm Karen will maintain mostly cloudy skies with light rain mixed with moderate showers and possible thunderstorms over the Windwards and, to a lesser extent, the southern Windwards and islands further south today. These conditions will gradually spread northwards over the Leewards by this afternoon. Meanwhile, tropical storm warnings remain in effect for Puerto Rico, the US and British Virgin Islands in anticipation of Tropical Storm Karen which is expected to move over these islands on Tuesday. Skies over these islands will be generally partly cloudy with localize showers mainly over Puerto Rico today. However, weather condition will begin to deteriorate during the morning tomorrow as The Tropical Storm approaches.

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
