**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:**

**Weather today:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with an 80 percent or high chance of showers and a 40 percent or moderate chance of thunderstorms.

**Weather tonight:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 70 percent or high chance of showers and a 30 percent or low chance of thunderstorms.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** The centre and core of tropical Storm Karen is now north of the region, however, squally conditions associated with the southeastern banding features will continue to affect Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands where cloudy skies, showers, thunderstorms and sometimes gusty winds are expected today into the evening. Some moist and unsettled air persisting across the Leewards will maintain a high chance of showers and a moderate chance of thunderstorms across the islands. Meanwhile, a dry and stable atmosphere will continue to dominate the Southern Caribbean; therefore, the chances of showers will remain low under partly cloudy skies across the Windward Islands south to Trinidad and Tobago.
