Weather Bulletin

Present Weather: Fair skies

Winds: Gentle Breeze of 9 mph from the East-northeast

Temperature: 28°C/81°F

Humidity: 63%

Sea Level Pressure: 1013.9mb or 29.94"

Sunrise: Tom 6:09 am

Sunset: Today 5:40 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: East at 6 to 12 mph.

Seas: 1.2 to 2.4 metres or 4 to 8 feet with northerly swells peaking to near 8 feet. **A high surf advisory and a high surf warning remain in effect for beachgoers.**

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:

Weather today: Partly sunny with a 30 percent or low chance of showers until mid morning; and partly cloudy to cloudy after mid morning into the afternoon with a 70 percent or high chance of showers and a 40 percent or moderate chance of thunderstorms.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 70 percent or high chance of showers and a 40 percent or moderate chance of thunderstorms.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Westward moving tropical wave supported by a trough will maintain high moisture levels and instability across the Windward Islands south to Trinidad where cloudy skies, showers and thunderstorms are expected. Meanwhile, low moisture in the atmosphere across the Northeast Caribbean will keep the chances of showers low across Puerto Rico east to the Leeward Islands during the early part of the morning; however; an increase in moisture and instability just prior to mid-day and beyond will increase the chances of showers and thunderstorms over the islands.
