Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A weak trough is affecting the area. It could heighten the chances for brief showers across the Islands.

Weather today: Partly sunny with a 40 percent or moderate chance of showers.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 40 percent or moderate chance of showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: A trough ahead of a cold front will produce unsettled weather mainly across the north-east Caribbean today while more settled conditions will prevail across the southern islands; except for Trinidad where rising air at the surface coupled with available moisture will generate cloudy spells with showers and possible thunderstorms. As the cold front moves further into our area, dry sinking air behind it will see more stable weather conditions tonight. Meanwhile, swells generated from Tropical Storm Sebastien will continue to maintain marginally unsafe seas for beachgoers mainly around the Atlantic side of the northeast Caribbean.
