Winds: East-southeast at 5 to 12mph becoming lighter and variable or even calm at times.

Seas: 1.8 to 2.8 metres or 6 to 9 feet, mainly in north easterly swells. High surf warning remains in place mainly for the north and eastern coastlines.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: The presence of a deep layered trough coupled with light south easterly winds and daytime heating could lead to a high chance for shower activity over and around the islands today and tonight.

Weather today: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with a 70 percent or high chance of showers and a 40 percent or moderate chance of thunderstorms mainly after midday.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with a 70 percent or high chance of showers and a 20 percent or slight chance of thunderstorms.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Across most of the Eastern Caribbean, the presence of a deep layered trough along with light winds and daytime heating could lead to a high chance of showers and a moderate chance of thunderstorms from the British Virgin Islands to the northern Windward Islands. For the rest of the islands, skies will be fair to partly cloudy with only a slight chance of a brief shower as high pressure ridge dominates.
