**Weather Bulletin**

**Issued at:** 7 am

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2019

**Present Weather:** Partly Cloudy

**Winds:** Light Breeze of 7 mph from the NORTH

**Temperature:** 25°C/77°F      **Humidity:** 89%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1014.0mb or 29.94"

**Sunrise:** Tom 6:10 am

**Sunset:** Today 5:38 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** East-southeast today becoming EAST by tonight with speeds ranging between 9 to 18 mph with strong gusts during showers.

**Seas:** 1.2 to 1.8 metres or 4 to 6 feet.

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:**

**Weather today:** Generally cloudy with showers and a 70 percent or high chance of thunderstorms.

**Weather tonight:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 60 percent or a moderate chance of showers.

Minor to moderate flooding is also possible as a result of showers becoming moderate to heavy at times producing possible rainfall totals of 25.4 to 76.2 mm or 1.0 to 3.0 inches spreading across portions of the islands. **A flash flood watch is currently in effect.**

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** The combination of a tropical wave and a deep-layered trough will produce unsettled weather conditions mainly across the northern islands. Cloudy skies with showers, some of which could be moderate to heavy at times, and a high chance of thunderstorm could be seen across these areas today. Islands from Guadeloupe southwards will see similar conditions resulting from that tropical wave mainly during the earlier part of today before a second approaching wave moves in later this afternoon giving rise to thundershower activity once again. Minor to moderate flooding is possible over the next 24 hours.
