**Present Weather:** Fair skies

**Winds:** A moderate breeze of 16mph from the Northeast

**Temperature:** 26°C / 79°F

**Humidity:** 71%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1016.6mbs or 30.02"

**Sunrise:** Tom 6:30 am

**Sunset:** Today 5:38 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** Northeast with speeds ranging between 14 to 23mph with occasional higher gusts.

**Seas:** 1.5 to 2.4 metres or 5 to 8 feet. The higher heights, however, are for the eastern side of the islands. **A small craft advisory is in effect.**

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:**

**Weather today:** Partly sunny and breezy with a 50 percent or a moderate chance of quick showers mainly during the afternoon.

**Weather tonight:** Partly cloudy and breezy with a 40 percent or a moderate chance of showers.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** A strong high-pressure system located in the northern Atlantic is the dominant weather feature. This is producing a steep pressure gradient over the area resulting in moderate to fresh breeze across the Eastern Caribbean. Notwithstanding, a series of weak low-level troughs generated by surges in the wind field could see periodic showers particularly for the islands in the northeast Caribbean. In addition to this, these breezy conditions will see a rise in wave heights causing sea conditions to be choppy and challenging for small craft operators.
