Present Weather: Fair skies

Winds: A moderate breeze of 15mph from the Northeast

Temperature: 25°C / 77°F

Humidity: 83%

Sea Level Pressure: 1014.5mbs or 29.96"

Sunset: Today 5:38 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: East-northeast at 14 to 21mph with higher gusts during showers as well as over open waters.

Seas: 2.1 metres or 7 feet. A warning is in place for small craft operators and beachgoers against hazardous sea conditions.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: The presence of an upper level trough will continue to enhance low level moisture being transported across the area on a fresh to brisk trade wind flow, thus maintaining an unstable atmosphere and by extension a high chance for shower activity over and around the islands today and tonight.

Weather today: Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with periods of brief passing showers, some of which could be moderate to locally heavy at times.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy skies with a 40 percent or moderate chance of showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Across the Eastern Caribbean, the presence of an upper level trough along with low level moisture being transported across the area on a relatively brisk trade wind flow will result in occasional showers with a slight chance of thunderstorms from the British Virgin Islands southwards to Trinidad & Tobago. Some showers could be moderate to locally heavy at times.
