Weather Bulletin

Present Weather: Partly cloudy skies

Winds: A gentle breeze of 12mph from the east-northeast

Temperature: 27°C / 80°F

Humidity: 87%

Sea Level Pressure: 1015.6mbs or 29.99"

Sunrise: Tom 6:25 am

Sunset: Today 5:36 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: East-southeast at 7 to 16mph.

Seas: 1.5 to 2.1 meters or 5 to 7 feet with northerly swells of 1.8 meters or 6 feet in the waters northeast of the islands. **A high surf advisory remains in effect.**

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: Moisture and instability associated with a weak surface trough will gradually diminish today as a ridge of high pressure regains dominance

Weather today: Partly cloudy to sometimes cloudy with a 40 percent or moderate chance of brief showers.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 20 percent or slight chance of brief showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Available moisture and weak instability associated with a weak surface trough will cause skies to be partly cloudy to cloudy with a moderate chance of showers over the Leewards and islands further south today with gradual reduction in showers expected by tonight. These conditions will affect the British Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico by tonight but until then, partly cloudy skies with a slight chance of showers will take place over these islands today.
