Sunday 12th January 2020.

Present Weather: Fair skies with showers in the vicinity

Winds: A fresh breeze of 22mph from the Northeast

Temperature: 26°C / 80°F **Max Temp:** 29°C / 84°F **Humidity:** 76%

Sea Level Pressure: 1020.1mbs or 30.12"

24hr rainfall at the R.L. Bradshaw Intl. at 2 pm: 3.9mm/0.15"

Amount of rainfall for the month of January: 38.9mm / 1.5"

Sunrise: Tom 6:43am

Sunset: Tom 5:55pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8 pm Tomorrow

Winds: East with speeds ranging between 20 to 31 mph with gusts during showers, over elevated terrains and over open waters. **A high wind advisory remains in effect.**

Seas: 2.8 to 4.0 metres or 9 to 13 feet with northeast swells averaging 1.5 metres or 5 feet. **A small craft warning remains in place and your vessels should stay in port. A high surf advisory is also in effect against hazardous breaking surfs.**

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A strong high pressure system in the north central Atlantic Ocean is producing a steep pressure gradient across the area and is generating a fresh to strong wind flow resulting in cloudy spells with showers and hazardous sea conditions. Come late tomorrow, a low to mid level trough will move close to the area and further enhance the showers causing them to be moderate and possibly heavy at times. Possible rainfall total for the forecast period is 6.0 to 19.0 mm or 0.25 to 0.75 inch.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy to cloudy and breezy with brisk showers and slightly hazy.

Weather tomorrow: Partly cloudy to cloudy and breezy with brisk showers and slightly hazy.
