**Present Weather:** Cloudy skies with Showers in the vicinity

**Winds:** A moderate breeze of 13mph from the East northeast

**Temperature:** 24°C / 75°F

**Humidity:** 86%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1015.5mbs or 29.98"

**Sunrise:** Tom 6:44 am

**Sunset:** Today 6:01 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** East at 14 to 21mph with lighter spells overnight.

**Seas:** 1.5 to 2.1 metres or 5 to 7 feet with northeasterly swells of 1.5 metres or 5 feet. **Small craft operators should continue to exercise caution, while a high surf advisory remains in effect during the morning. Swells are forecast to decrease this afternoon into tonight.**

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:**

**Weather today:** Partly cloudy skies with a 60 percent or moderate chance of showers during the morning, with the chance of showers decreasing into the afternoon.

**Weather tonight:** Fair to partly cloudy skies with a 20 percent or slight chance of a brief shower.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** Across the Eastern Caribbean from the British Virgin Islands southwards to Trinidad & Tobago, the presence of a dissipating frontal trough along with a moderate to fresh trade wind flow transporting shallow low level patches across the area will maintain a moderate chance for showers over and around the islands during the next 24 hours.
