Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: Lingering moisture and instability from a weak trough could maintain a moderate chance for shower activity over and around the islands this morning. However, a drier and more stable airmass will replace this trough later today into tonight and significantly reduce the chances for shower activity across the area during that time.

Weather today: Partly cloudy skies with a 60 percent or moderate chance of showers during the morning with these chances gradually reducing thereafter.

Weather tonight: Fair to partly cloudy skies tonight with a 20 percent or slight chance of a brief shower.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: The presence of a weak trough will maintain a very high chance of showers across the British Virgin Islands and the northern Leeward Islands during the next 24 hours. Meanwhile, for the rest of the Eastern Caribbean, skies will be fair to partly cloudy with only a slight chance of a brief shower as a dry and stable airmass moves into the area.
