Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2020

**Present Weather:** Partly cloudy with light showers

**Winds:** A fresh breeze of 21mph from the Northeast

**Temperature:** 26°C / 79°F

**Humidity:** 84%

**Sea Level Pressure:** 1019.7mbs or 30.11"

**Sunrise:** Tom 6:43 am

**Sunset:** Today 5:53 pm

**Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow**

**Winds:** East-northeast 18 to 28 mph with higher gusts during showers, as well as over open waters and elevated areas.

**Seas:** Reaching 2.1 to 3.1 metres or 7 to 10 feet. **A warning is in effect for small craft operators against hazardous sea conditions, hence they should remain in port.**

**Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis:** Partly cloudy skies with a 60 percent or moderate chance of showers during the morning, with these chances decreasing in the afternoon.

**Weather tonight:** Partly cloudy skies with a 60 percent or moderate chance of showers late tonight into the early morning hours.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** Across the Eastern Caribbean from the British Virgin Islands southwards to Trinidad & Tobago, we can expect partly cloudy skies with periods of increased cloudiness and a moderate chance of showers, as a fresh to brisk trade wind flow generated by a strong Atlantic high pressure system continues to transport pockets of low level moisture over and around the islands.
