Weather Forecast Valid until 8 pm Tomorrow

Winds: East with speeds ranging between 14 to 23mph with gusts during showers, over elevated terrains and over open waters.

Seas: 1.8 to 2.8 metres or 6 to 9 feet with northeast swells averaging 1.5 metres or 5 feet. A small craft warning for small craft operators remains in place until midday after which it will be replaced by a small craft advisory for the rest of the period. Also, a high surf advisory remains in effect for beachgoers against dangerous breaking surf.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A mid to upper level trough over the area is enhancing moisture at the surface resulting in unsettled weather across the area. Meanwhile, the pressure gradient is weakening and moderate to fresh winds will now persist across the area. Notwithstanding, seas will remain hazardous for small craft operators and sea bathers. Possible rainfall total for the forecast period is 5.0 to 10.0 mm or 0.20 to 0.40 inch.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a 70 percent or a high chance of showers.

Weather tomorrow: Partly sunny with a 50 percent or a moderate chance of showers mainly before midday.
