Weather Forecast Valid until 8 pm Tomorrow

Winds: Easterly at 12 to 21mph with higher spells over coastal waters and elevated terrain and gusting higher in some showers.

Seas: 1.8 or 2.4 meters or 6 to 8 feet in the waters east of the Islands and a small craft advisory remains in effect for these waters. The waters on the western side of the Islands are safer for marine activities.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A mid to upper trough continues over the area. This feature is expected to enhance patchy low level clouds embedded within a moderate to fresh windflow leading to an increased chance of shower activity over the Leewards tonight and tomorrow. Rainfall could total between 5 to 25.4 mm or .20 to 1 inch during the next 24 hours. Therefore, skies over St. Kitts and Nevis tonight will be partly cloudy to cloudy with a 60 percent or a moderate chance of showers. Tomorrow will be mostly cloudy with a with a mixture of passing showers and lighter rain. END
