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Weather Bulletin

Present Weather: Cloudy

Winds: A moderate breeze of 15mph from the east

Temperature: 26°C / 80°F **Max Temp:** 29°C / 84°F **Humidity:** 73%

Sea Level Pressure: 1017.0mbs or 30.03"

Weather Forecast Valid until 8 pm Tomorrow

Winds: East with speeds ranging between 14 to 23mph.

Seas: 1.8 to 2.4metres or 6 to 8feet. A small craft caution is in effect mainly for the open waters on the eastern side of the Islands.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A weak low level trough will move across the area tomorrow however, low moisture levels will restrict significant shower activity. Following closely behind this trough is Saharan dust which is expected to reduce air quality levels over the next few days. In the mean time, fresh to moderate breeze will keep sea conditions above normal thus generating choppy seas for mariners. Therefore, skies over St. Kitts and Nevis will be partly cloudy with a 30 percent or a low chance of showers. Tomorrow will be partly sunny and Hazy with a 40 percent or a moderate chance of showers mainly in the afternoon.
