Weather today: Partly cloudy with a 40 percent or moderate chance of showers.

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 50 percent or moderate chance of showers.

**Eastern Caribbean Forecast:** Despite the presence of a broad area of high pressure, a couple of low-level troughs will move across the Islands to generate brief cloudiness and showers. Skies therefore from Puerto Rico, southwards to Trinidad and Tobago could be partly cloudy, becoming cloudy at times today and tonight, with a moderate chance of showers.
