Weather Bulletin

Issued at:7am Tuesday 10th March 2020

Present Weather: Cloudy

Winds: A moderate breeze of 16mph from the east

Temperature: 24°C / 75°F **Humidity:** 77%

Sea Level Pressure: 1018.6mb or 30.08"

Sunrise: Tom 6:21 am Sunset: Today 6:20 pm

Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow

Winds: East with speeds ranging between 12 to 21mph with gusts to around 32mph

Seas: 1.8 to 2.4metres or 6 to 8feet consisting of north to northeasterly swells averaging 1.8metres or 6feet. The high surf advisory remains in effect mainly for the coastal waters on the northern side of the Islands.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: Today will be generally sunny. Tonight will be partly cloudy with a 20 percent or a slight chance of early morning showers.

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Notwithstanding the presence of a stationary front in the vicinity of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands, generally settled conditions are expected as available moisture for shower development is low and significant showers are not anticipated. Meanwhile, high pressure will dominate the rest of the Island chain with, at most, a moderate chance of showers materializing mainly across the northern Windward Islands. On the other hand, hazardous breaking surfs will be a challenge for beach goers for the coastal waters of Puerto Rico to Guadeloupe.
