<u>Weather Forecast Valid until 8am Tomorrow</u>

Winds: East at 12 to 21mph with possible gusts to 32mph mainly over elevated terrain.

Seas: 1.2 to 1.8 meters or 4 to 6 feet. A small craft caution remains in effect mainly for choppy seas on the windward side of the islands.

Weather Forecast for St. Kitts & Nevis: A slightly tighter pressure gradient will maintain a moderate to sometimes fresh breeze over the Leewards and the British Virgin Islands today and tonight while low moisture levels will continue to restrict shower activity over these islands today. Tonight, a weak tropical wave could slightly increase the chance of passing showers over the Leewards

Weather today: Partly cloudy with a 20 percent or slight chance of a brief passing shower

Weather tonight: Partly cloudy with a 40 percent or moderate chance of brief overnight showers

Eastern Caribbean Forecast: Shallow pockets of moisture embedded within a moderate to sometimes fresh wind flow will cause brief periods of increased cloudiness and light passing showers over the Windwards and islands further south today. Later tonight and into tomorrow, the frequency of the showers will increase mainly over Trinidad and Tobago, the Windwards and to a lesser extent Barbados as tropical wave interacts with an upper level trough. The rest of the islands which include the Leewards westward to Puerto Rico will see generally stable and breezy conditions with a slight chance of showers today and a moderate chance of brief showers tonight due to a weak tropical wave.

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
