<b>Pedestrian</b>	0
<b>Injuries</b>	2 -- Mr. Morris and his passenger, Atalia Newton of Ramsbury, Nevis, were transported to the Joseph N. France General Hospital for medical attention. They were treated and later discharged.
<b>Fatalities</b>	0
<b>Circumstances</b>	<p>Preliminary investigations indicate that while Mr. Morris was travelling from Cayon towards Basseterre, he lost control of the vehicle when he encountered a pool of water. Despite his reported efforts to regain vehicular control, it ran off the road, collided with an electrical pole, and subsequently overturned.</p> <p>Mr. Morris was arrested on the scene as he did not have a valid driver's license.</p>
