Injuries	2 Mr. Morris and his passenger, Atalia Newton of Ramsbury, Nevis, were transported to the Joseph N. France General Hospital for medical attention. They were treated and later discharged.

Circumstances	Preliminary investigations indicate that while Mr. Morris was travelling from Cayon towards Basseterre, he lost control of the vehicle when he encountered a pool of water. Despite his reported efforts to regain vehicular control, it ran off the road, collided with an electrical pole, and subsequently overturned.
	Mr. Morris was arrested on the scene as he did not have a valid driver's license.
