<b>Circumstances</b>	Investigations indicate that both vehicles were travelling from east to west along the island main road. When in the vicinity of <i>The Democrat</i> , Mr. Liburd stopped to offload a passenger. While at a standstill, Ms. Williams collided with the rear of his vehicle.
