<b>Injuries</b>	1 -- Mr. Williams was rendered unconscious by the accident and rushed to the Joseph N. France General Hospital via EMS ambulance. He was warded in serious condition following a medical assessment that revealed brain swelling, a fractured left arm, and bruises about the body. As of September 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 2023, Mr. Williams had not regained consciousness. He remains hospitalised with his overall condition unchanged. A medical form was issued and given to his mother, Angela Williams of Bird Rock, St. Kitts.
<b>Fatalities</b>	0
<b>Circumstances</b>	Preliminary investigations into the accident revealed that Mr. Williams was travelling towards Conaree from Basseterre's direction. Ms. Barrate, coming from the Taylor's Range roundabout, attempted a right turn at the junction of Needsmust and Bladen's in the vicinity of the St. Kitts Cooperative Credit Union. While she was making the turn, Mr. Williams was overtaking and collided with the front right fender and bumper of Ms. Barrate's vehicle. This caused him and his motorcycle to collide with a pole on the seaside of the road and fall into the drain.
