Circumstances	Preliminary investigations suggest that Ms. Morales was parked on the left hand side of the road facing north in the vicinity of <i>Bass Bakery</i> . While she was exiting said parked position, Mr. Morris, who was also travelling north, collided with her front right wheel. This caused Ms. Morales to collide with the right side of Mr. Hanley's vehicle which was parked in the spot ahead of Ms. Morales. Mr. Morris subsequently lost control of his vehicle and collided with the front of Mr. Bass' vehicle that was parked on the right hand side of the road before coming to a stop.
