Circumstances	<p>Investigations suggest that both Mr Stevens and Mr Liburd were travelling towards Basseterre. When they arrived in the vicinity of the University of Medical and Health Sciences (UMHS), Mr Liburd stopped behind two (2) vehicles, waiting for the traffic to clear. Mr Stevens came from behind and collided with the rear of Mr Liburd's vehicle.</p> <p>Mr Stevens was arrested at the scene of the accident for the offences of Driving without a valid or Unexpired driver's license; Driving without being covered by insurance; and Driving without Due Care and Attention. He was charged with each offence at the Basseterre Police Station on the same day.</p>
