<b>Circumstances</b>	Investigations indicate that both drivers were travelling towards Basseterre. Mr Roache reported that veered off the road because he looked away when an item fell off a seat inside his vehicle. Upon manoeuvring back onto the road, he skidded and collided with the rear tyre of the motorbike ahead, causing Mr Carty to lose control and tumble to the ground.
