<b>Circumstances</b>	Initial investigations indicate that Mr Chaderton was travelling along Sandown Road towards the sea. He exited the stop when the traffic light turned green and while doing so, Mr Rogers, who was travelling east along the Bay Road, collided with the right side of Mr Chaderton's vehicle.
